




# Parent Curriculum Overview

Autumn Term 2021 Class 4

### ENGLISH

In our writing, we shall be studying the following texts: 13 Words, Anthology of Intriguing Animals, Snow Globe and A River. These texts introduce pupils to fictional, information texts, traditional tales, narratives and poetry.



In our reading, we will be covering a range of texts focussing on 4 main strands of reading comprehension: explain, retrieve, infer and choice.

# MATHEMATICS

This term, there will be a focus on number. This will be through place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will be encouraging the children to represent their



ideas in concrete methods first but develop this so they can perform calculations mentally and fluently.

We will be doing lots of times tables practice, learning tables 0-12 in preparation for the times table test at the end of the academic year.

## SCIENCE

For science, we will be studying living things and their associated habitats. We will be learning about man made and natural changes to the



environment and its habitats, such as deforestation and floods. We will also be investigating various animal groups and conduct investigations surrounding our local environment.

#### GEOGRAPHY AND HISTORY

This term, we will be studying forests for our Geography unit. We will be focussing on making comparisons between our local forests and the



Amazon Rainforest in Brazil. In this unit, we shall be covering a range of map skills, comparing a range of human and physical features investigating layers of forests and examining woodland life.

In History, we will be covering invasion. This will link to the period of Roman Britain and colonialization. We will explore in detail how the Celts tried to defend Britain from the Romans. We will discover how the Romans were still able to successfully siege Britain, even though they were greatly outnumbered!


