



Parent Curriculum Overview

Summer Term 1 - 2021 - CLASS 6

ENGLISH

This half term we are starting by writing non-fiction texts on 101 Things to do to Become a Superhero... or evil genius! We will endeavour to use a formal tone whilst imparting information quickly and concisely as your average superhero or villain doesn't have the time to hang around reading all day. We will then write a mix of formal and informal letters to show off our control of the written English language.

MATHEMATICS

In our Maths this half term, we will mix measuring area, perimeter, volume and mass and converting between units of metric measure before we embark on a whistle stop tour of imperial units. We will then be darting here and there through the Maths World focussing on securing all the things that are important for them to take into Year 7 with them such as a fractions recap and practice of formal methods and times tables.

SCIENCE

In Science our focus will be on the classification of living things in our, "Living Things and Their Habitats," unit. We will zoom in on the work of Carl Linneaus and how Darwin's work added detail to his methods. Flow Diagrams and classification Keys will be the order of the day. We will then hopefully get out and about and carry out some real life classification in the local area but that is obviously COVID permitting.

History

Our history focus will be on Martin Luther King and his leadership of the Civil Rights Movement in the US. We will start off by looking at Dr King himself and the peaceful but assertive attributes he brought to and helped to instil in the movement. We will then zoom out a bit and look at the movement and it's achievements in a wider historical context looking at what came before and the conversations that we can still see are incredibly important to people in the US today.

COMPUTING

Data is the name of the game this half term in our ICT work where we will look at how data is gathered, shared and understood byt technology and humans alike.

ART or DT

Our Art will coincide nicely with The Civil Rights Movement and the power that photography and images gave the Civil Rights Movement. We will learn to take photos and then edit and publish them on the computer.

MUSIC

Our music will be based around songs that calm people and the techniques and skills that bring about a calming effect on humans around the world.

RE

Our R.E. this term will cover the concept that Jesus is a "King" but begin to explore and establish what the word King means in a religious context.

PΕ

Mr Pepper will help us to develop our Cricketing skills while we also develop our technique and tactics in both football and netball.

PSHE

Our PSHE topic this half term is "Relationships" which encompasses mental health, love and loss, power and control and safe relationships online.

MFL

Mr Pepper is taking the children for French and will be focussing on time and the Summer Holidays.
