

Parent Curriculum Overview

Summer Term 1 2021 Class 4

ENGLISH

In English this half term, we will be looking at how we can build atmosphere in our writing using a showing and not telling. We will also be exploring paragraphs and how we use these in our Writing.

MATHEMATICS

This half term we will be exploring decimals and measure. We will be looking at our times tables and making connections between our 2s, 4s and 8s.

Learning times tables remains a high priority, with the children expected to know up to 12x12 by the end of year 4. Please support your child at home by practising these number facts regularly as part of the home learning.



SCIENCE

Our topic for this half term is Animals including Humans. We will be exploring the digestive system and the role of our teeth. We will also look at food chains. We will explore staying healthy as part of this unit.



HISTORY

This half term our theme is the Ancient Greeks and the Olympic Games. We will be learning about the first Olympic games and then we will host our own class Olympics! We will try some



COMPUTING

This half term in Computing we will be focusing on Investigating Weather. We will look at researching and storing data. We will then explore how to use a green screen.

ART

This half term we will be exploring pottery using clay. We will link this learning to our History work on Ancient Greece. We will also be exploring the Artist Clarice Cliff. We will use clay to make our own pots.
