












Parent Curriculum Overview Summer 1 2021 Class 3

<p><u>ENGLISH</u></p>  <p>In English this half term, we are looking at the text 'Story Path' which is a 'choose your own adventure' book. We will be writing our own adventure stories focussing on speech. We will also be looking at poetry from the book 'Poetry Pie'.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p>  <p>In maths we are continuing with our Fractions unit, building up to working out fractions of numbers. We will be recapping fractions from Year 2 as we will have missed some of that learning last year. We will also be looking at Time.</p>
<p><u>DT</u></p>  <p>In DT this term we will be exploring an outdoor learning unit. We will be solving the problem of 'How can we wash our hands in the outdoor learning area?'. We will be exploring different types of taps using levers and pulleys and building them from natural materials.</p>	<p><u>History</u></p>  <p>Our topic this half term is 'Queen Elizabeth II'. We have lots of exciting things planned for this topic, including a 1950's day, visitors to tell us about the day the Queen was coronated and we will also be looking at her life and family tree. What do we think Charles' coronation will look like?</p>
<p><u>COMPUTING</u></p>  <p>In computing we will be learning programming, using the Scratch software. With its block based approach to coding. We will learning to tell stories and create simple games.</p>	<p><u>SCIENCE</u></p>  <p>Our topic in Science this term is 'Forces and Magnets'. We will be doing Science with Ms Kellman and doing lots of investigations to discover friction, magnetism and other forces.</p>
<p><u>RE</u></p>  <p>This half-term in RE we are discussing 'What kind of world would Jesus want?'. We will be discussing ethical and moral questions and working out solutions to problems. We will be looking at different scenarios to work out the difference between 'right' and 'wrong' and discuss what to do if something is in between.</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p>  <p>On Tuesday we will working with a PE specialist to learn how to attack and defend in netball. On Fridays with Miss Angell we will be learning how to play rounders.</p>
<p><u>PSHE</u></p>  <p>Our PSHE unit is relationships. We will be talking all about friendships, being a global citizen and how to keep ourselves safe in our communities.</p>	<p><u>MUSIC</u></p>  <p>This half term in Music we will be working with Ms Kellman to learn how to compose music using glockenspiels.</p>
<p><u>MFL</u></p>  <p>In MFL with Ms Kellman we are continuing with our French lessons. We will be learning how to talk all about our school and the different subjects.</p>	<p><u>Home Learning and important information</u></p> <p>PE days will be Tuesdays and Fridays although PE Kit will only be needed on the Tuesday.
