




Parent Curriculum Overview

Autumn Term 2021 Class 5

ENGLISH

This term we will start by exploring a text by Oliver Jeffers - The Day The Crayons Quit - and will look at personification, letter writing and creating humour



for our reader through a series of letters. We will then begin to look at parenthesis and modal verbs (such as might, will, could, should) to add detail to our sentences concisely. Other texts we'll be using will be 'Stuff you should Know!' and Ripley's Mighty Machines - as our non-fiction models of writing and 'Weslandia' to develop some serious creativity in our writing too.

MATHEMATICS

This term we will develop our understanding of place value and the 4 number operations. We will also be looking at using data and statistics in

year is Italy and so we have started the year with a look at Italian culture, language and Geography. This term our specific Geography topic is based on the study of Volcanos and their formation and place in the rock cycle.
