

Parent Curriculum Overview

Summer Term 2021- Class 6

We have a very exciting term coming up. This term we have the Year 6 residential, a KS2 performance and the Year 6 leaver's assembly! I know Year 6 are very excited about their hoodies too.

ENGLISH

This term we will be looking at a range of different texts. We will be applying our learning from throughout the year to produce a number of pieces of writing. This term we are thinking about audience and purpose and how we can write as a reader. We will be thinking about our punctuation and vocabulary and how we can use this to suit the purpose of our text.

MATHEMATICS

This term we will be applying our mathematical knowledge into a number of different real life contexts. The projects provide an opportunity to revisit many of the skills and curriculum content covered both in Year 6 and also the rest of Key Stage 2. The projects have been designed to explore maths in real life contexts, allowing children to see how important maths is in all aspects of life.

SCIENCE

In Science, we are beginning the term with a topic called Animals Including Humans. The children will be able to identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system. They will be able to talk about the function of their heart, blood vessels and blood. We will also look at the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function. Building on this, they will be able to describe how nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans. The second topic we will be exploring is Light. We will be looking at how we see things using light and also exploring shadows.



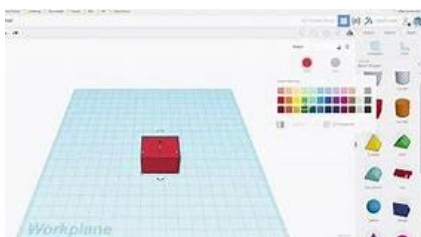
GEOGRAPHY AND HISTORY

This term we are beginning with a history topic. We will be looking at a significant person: Martin Luther King Jr. We will be exploring the question: *How and why should we remember Martin Luther King Jr?* We will explore some key historical events and the impact he has made on life today. Following this, we will continue our topic will look at Sustainability through Renewable Energy. We will be exploring why our school has solar panels. We will also be taking a trip to the Plymouth recycling centre to explore how rubbish is turned into energy.



COMPUTING

Our computing units this term are 3D Modelling and Sensing (programming). We will be using TinkerCad to create 3D models. We will look at how we can resize, colour and move 3D objects.



ART

We are going to be exploring the work of Paul Klee. We will also be exploring how to use Watercolour. We will be developing different techniques and looking at how we can use watercolour to shade.
