

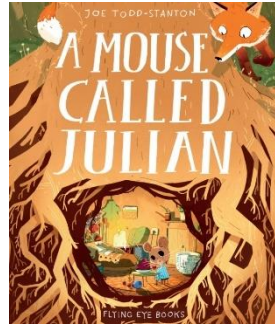
Parent Curriculum Overview

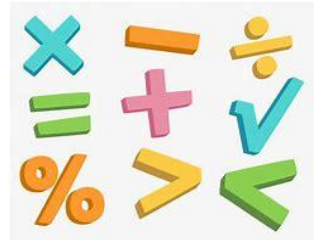
ENGLISH

This term we will be exploring a text by Joe Todd- Stanton. We will familiarise ourselves with the text structure used in our text 'A mouse called Julian', focussing on developing our narrative writing. Within this text we have looked at verbs and how to change them from present tense to past tense. We will then look at 'Wanted'.



MATHEMATICS

This term we have been learning how to tell the time to the hour, half past, quarter to and quarter past. We will be looking at length and height. In this unit we will be measuring different heights and lengths, comparing different sizes and adding and finding the differences of lengths and heights together. We will then move on to develop our understanding of position and directions. This will look at using directional language such as left, right, up and down as well as using half and quarter turns to give directions. We will continue to practice our 2s, 5s and 10s times tables.



SCIENCE

We are coming to the end of our topic of plants. We are soon going to go onto "animals and their habitats" We will be exploring dead and living objects, animal food chains and why different animals are suited for different habitats.

We will be investigating animals in their natural habitats this includes bug hunts, using the school's pond and more!



GEOGRAPHY AND HISTORY

This term our history topic is Nelson Mandela and Rosa Parks. We will be exploring the civil rights movement and how it became. We will be looking at how individuals such as Rosa Park and Nelson Mandela influenced history.



COMPUTING

In Computing the children will be learning how to make music using Chrome Music Lab.

Though this unit we will be exploring music by looking at the rhythm and the beat from different musical pieces and creating our own on the computers. The children will be able to compare making music on a computer and making music using instruments.



Art

This term we have been looking at Bridget Riley who specialising in optical illusion art. The children have had so much fun learning how to mix secondary colour pants and will soon be designing their own design. The children will be painting their final piece onto a canvas and will be able to take it home.
