As you are probably aware, South Dartmoor Multi-Academy Trust is in the process of transferring to a new trust. This will mean that Buckfastleigh Primary School, along with the other local schools in our trust, will move to join another one during this academic year. Initially we were aiming for a very ambitious 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 transfer date. However, it is more realistic to look at a 1<sup>st</sup> February transfer date. I do have to add that, if there were to be a general election, then this could add at least an extra 6 weeks to the decision making process due to the impact on government departments at this time. As new information becomes available, I will endeavour to keep you as up to date as possible. In the meantime, this will have no effect on the school as we will be continuing with our primary focus, the care and education of your children.
