KS2 Production

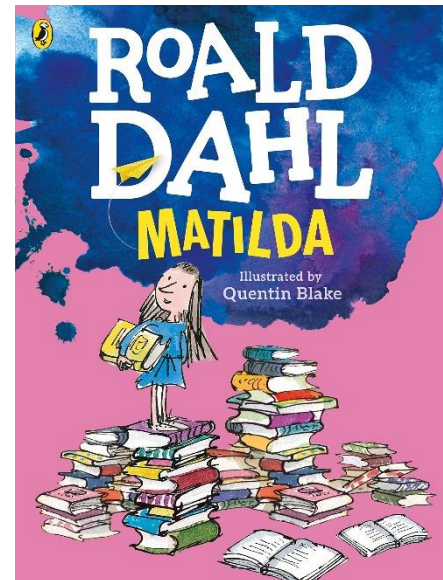

On Tuesday and Wednesday mornings next week, all the children will be moving to their new classrooms to spend time getting to know their new teachers.

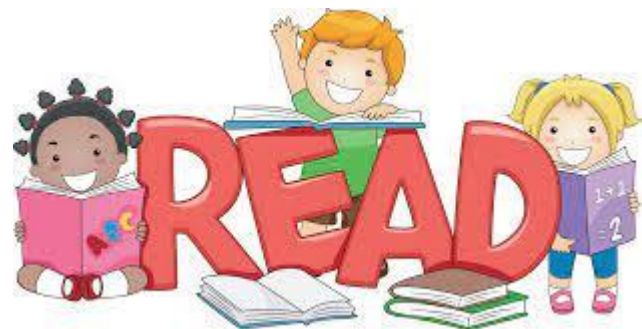
Matilda at South Dartmoor
