How does Buckfastleigh Primary School support a child with SEND?



We follow the Devon Graduated Response Cycle

Assess: We monitor children closely and identify their needs.

Plan: We plan interventions and activities that the children may need.

Do: For up to half a term, children will participate in the interventions and activities that we have planned.

Review: We will review the progress that children have made and then start the cycle again accordingly.

What should I do if I think my child has special educational needs?

Please talk to us. The first point of call is to talk to your child's class teacher.

The class teacher may decide to organise a meeting with the Special Educational Needs Coordinator (SENDCo), Rosina Kellman.

At that meeting we will:

- Gather views and aspirations of your child
- Listen to any concerns you may have
- Plan any additional support your child may need.
- Discuss any referrals to outside professionals to support your child.
