



ENGLISH

We will be reading a variety of fiction and non-fiction text related to our topic with a focus on *My Secret War Diary*, by Marcia Williams and *Solo* by Roald Dahl. We will be writing newspaper reports, diary extracts, poetry, information text and children will learn to use and apply their grammatical knowledge. Weekly spellings will be set.

MATHEMATICS

We will continue to revise and extend our understanding of a range of mathematical concepts including fractions & decimals, place value, time. Algebra and there will be a continued focus on learning times tables to 12 x12. Children will be encouraged to develop their ability to explain their own reasoning.

HISTORY

Children will be expanding and developing their understanding of how the lives of ordinary people were affected by the war. We will be learning about the political developments at the time and the role of women. Children will use a range of primary and secondary resources.
